Examples (city examples include state and county)

\$1,000,000 Building

The real estate property tax bill would be \$9,040 (KY-\$1,240/Union-\$7,800).

The real estate property tax bill in the city would be \$14,450 (Mor.)/ \$13,490 (Sturgis)

\$1,000,000 Manufacturing Equipment

The mfg equipment property tax bill would be \$1,500 (KY-\$1,500/Union-\$0)

The mfg equipment property tax bill in the city would be \$1,500.

\$1,000,000 Tangible Property (Office Equipment/Conveyor Belt/Etc.)

The tangible property tax bill would be \$12,964 (KY-\$4,500/Union-\$8,464)

The tangible property tax bill in the city would be \$21,374 (Mor.)/ \$15,204 (Sturgis)

* Union Rate is composed of the county rate along with the school, library, health department, and extension service. To determine the rate for property located in a municipality, add the county rate to the city rate. The cities of Uniontown and Waverly are also taxing districts.
