**FORTIS PLASTICS TO RETAIN HENDERSON PLANT &  
LOCATE PORTION OF CORPORATE CENTER HERE**

HENDERSON, Ky.—Fortis Plastics, LLC, announced today that it will retain its 130-employee manufacturing facility in Henderson, Ky, while also locating a portion of its new corporate operations there.

Fortis, a diversified custom molding supplier for the appliance, furniture, building products, industrial, automotive and medical device industries, has recently consolidated and/or closed several facilities including three manufacturing plants in Indiana and one in Tennessee.

“Fortis’ decision to not only retain the Henderson facility but also to locate all corporate finance, as well as most of manufacturing support, here is great for this region,” said Marty Littrel, NWKF Existing Business Chairman. “This decision not only saves jobs in this difficult environment but also reinforces Fortis’ faith in Northwest Kentucky.”

NWKF, the City of Henderson, the Kentucky Cabinet for Economic Development, and the Kentucky Education and Workforce Development Cabinet partnered to assist Fortis including approving the company for up to \$4.6 million in tax incentives and training funds.
